<u>WHITE EXPECTANCY</u>	
GB1801	Cronulla Era “Kouri” x [(Joan’s Era x Kuranulla) x Fresh Charisma] “Guru”: Expect crystalline whites with good shape. Compact plants, free flowering.

GB1802	Winter Enigma “Polaris” x (Fresh Charisma x Serene Splash) “Pastel”: Expect large non-staining whites and pastel ice greens with big beautiful blush lips.

GB1803	Cronulla Star “Blessing” x Laramie Angel “Tee Pee”: Very early season productive whites on compact growing plants. Show content. “Blessing” flowers late April.

GB1804	Cronulla Star “Blessing” x Anna Dragon “Wow”: Intermediate to small standard pristine whites early in the season.



GB1805	Cronulla Star “Blessing” x (Purely Dreaming x Ultimate Ray) “LOL”: Ultra early “Blessing” crossed with white alba with white labellum. Early whites, mystery lips.

<u>GREEN EXPECTANCY</u>	
GB1806	Daintree Showers “Greenoble” x Green Connie “V1”: Early, beautiful big non-staining greens with red vee lips on good stems. Compact growth. Show bench.

GB1807	Daintree Showers “Greenoble” x Green Connie “V2”: “V2” large full shape with big labellum. Early to mid-season greens. Show content. Green Connie’s are compact.
GB1807	
GB1808	Daintree Showers “Greenoble” x Green Connie “V3”: “V3” is a vibrant green with bright red lip. Clean productive greens, good stems and compact growth content.

GB1809	Daintree Showers “Greenoble” x Connie Island “Ariadne”: “Ariadne’ is a flat non-staining green, excellent shape with very compact growth. Show greens with red lips.

<p>GB1810</p>	<p>Connie Island “Ariadne” x Green Connie “V1”: Neither of these parents have the coarse foliage that has plagued greens. Both large flat flowers. Clean show greens.</p>
<p>GB1810</p>	
<p>GB1811</p>	<p>Green Connie “V1” x (Foxfire Generation x Conqueso) “Carey”: “Carey” is an alba carrier later in the season. Large flat tough flower. Mid-season greens. Big lips.</p>
<p>GB1811</p>	
<p><u>Predominantly Gold/ Orange/Yellow Expectancy</u></p>	
<p>GB1812</p>	<p>[Blazing Fury x (Dream Temple x Trinity Gold)] “Vader” x (Trace’s Bullion x Intense Gold) “Buddy”: Very productive, good shape and high colour. Stunning lips.</p>
<p>GB1812</p>	
<p>GB1813</p>	<p>[Blazing Fury x (Dream Temple x Trinity Gold)] “Vader” x [(Dream Temple x Trinity Gold) x Harbour City] “Marjorine”: Productive golds and yellows. Possible but unlikely alba %. Strongly marked lips. Straight upright self-supporting spikes.</p>

<p>GB1814</p>	<p>(Purely Dreaming “Phoenix” x Lunar Advent) “Dawn” x Purely Dreaming “Gosh”: “Dawn” good May flowering alba carrier. “Gosh” gives shape/ colour. 25% albas.</p>
<p>GB1814</p>	
<p><u>Albas / Pure Colour Expectancy</u></p>	
<p>GB1815</p>	<p>Purely Dreaming “Phoenix” x Ocean “Tee Pee”: “Phoenix” has impressed as a parent. “Tee Pee” has good shape late. White, yellow & green albas. Early to late.</p>

<p>GB1816</p>	<p>Purely Dreaming Phoenix” x (Loch Watten x Ice Nymph) “Sparkle”: Big flat alba whites, yellows, creams and greens. Good growers. Early to mid-season.</p>

<p>GB1817</p>	<p>(Purely Dreaming x Ultimate Ray) “Sorbet” x (Loch Watten x Ice Nymph) “Sparkle”: Big white and cream alba with big contrasting gold lips on strong straight spikes.</p>

<p>GB1818</p>	<p>(Purely Dreaming x Ultimate Ray) "Sorbet" x Ocean "Tee Pee": Mid to late season whites, creams and some green albas. Once again yellow feature lips.</p>
<p>GB1818</p>	
<p>GB1819</p>	<p>(Purely Dreaming x Ultimate Ray) "LOL" x Ocean "Tee Pee": Looking for shapely whites, content with pure white lip. Good growers. Early to mid-season.</p>
<p>GB1819</p>	
<p><u>Predominantly Red Expectancy</u></p>	
<p>GB1821</p>	<p>Regal Flame "Queen of Hearts" x (Wyong Ruby x O'Beaston) "Ogre": Expect some intermediates and small standards. Dark red colour range with heavily coloured lips.</p>
<p>GB1821</p>	
<p>GB1822*</p>	<p>Splatters "Flamenco" x (Wyong Ruby x O'Beaston) "Ogre": Intermediates to small standards. Dark lips and spotted segments. Possibly 3n, "Flamenco" uncertain ploidy.</p>

<p>GB1823</p>	<p>(Wyong Ruby x O’Beaston) “Ogre” x Street Tango “Desiree”: Last Tango ancestry on both sides of parentage. Mainly intermediates with upright stems. Reds and browns.</p>
<p>GB1823</p>	
<p>GB1824</p>	<p>Pepper Blaze “Wraith” x Street Tango “Desiree”: Plum and dark chocolate coloured intermediates and small standards in mid-season. Good shape. Upright stems.</p>
<p>GB1824</p>	
<p><u>Splashes, Spots Expectancy</u></p>	
<p>GB1825</p>	<p>[(Cape Bailey x Lancashire Rose) x Flaming Vulcan] “Finale” x Kimberley Splash “TP” : Late season electric pinks with splashes. Contrasting red lips. Tall spikes, big flowers.</p>
<p>GB1825</p>	
<p>GB1826</p>	<p>Serene Splash “Angelina” x Kimberley Splash “TP”: Unusual splashes on background of white, pink or even green. Blush or red edged lips. Good shape, unusual outcomes.</p>

<p>GB1828*</p>	<p>Splatters "Flamenco" x (Loch Watten x Ice Nymph) "Sparkle": Hidden colour in the alba unleashed by "Flamenco". Standard size flowers, compact plants. Spots.</p>
<p>GB1828*</p>	
<p>* Apart from the two crosses using Splatters "Flamenco" (GB1822 and GB1828), the expectancy is for a tetraploid (4n) outcome.</p>
