








GB1901	Cronulla Star “Blessing” x Justis Pearl “BJ” FCC/AOC: Expect beautiful shape clean whites from very early in the season. High content of compact growers.

GB1902	Cronulla Star “Blessing” x (Justis Pearl x Fresh Charisma) “Noni”: Beautiful non staining whites with red edged lips. Very early and compact.

GB1903	Cronulla Star “Blessing” x Loch Watten “Dural”: Very early season alba carriers. “Dural” is a large flower with good lip. A fine mixture of alba and non-alba genes.

<u>Green/ Yellow Expectancy</u>		
GB1907	Green Connie “V2” x (Trace’s Bullion x Intense Gold) Buddy”: “Buddy” has been giving fantastic results. Large greens & yellows with full shape and huge lips.

GB1908	Coraki Glowing “Kentlyn” x Green Elation “Scion”: “Scion” is proving to be an excellent parent and has compact growth while the Show winning “Kentlyn” doesn’t. Outstanding greens and yellows with red vee lips.



<u>Pinks/ Blush/ Splash Expectancy</u>	
GB1909	Kimberley Splash “TP” x Justis Pearl “BJ” FCC/AOC: “TP” has been giving good results for shape but not so much splashing. Good shape pastels & whites.

GB1910	Valley Samerantz “Delightful” x Justis Pearl “BJ” FCC/AOC: Soft -limited availability.

<u>Predominantly Gold/ Orange/Yellow Expectancy</u>	
GB1911	Coraki Glowing “Kentlyn” x (Trace’s Bullion x Intense Gold) Buddy”: Two of the very best yellows combined. Expect excellent shape and colour results & red vee lips.

GB1912	Rui Xavier “Veldt” x (Trace’s Bullion x Intense Gold) Buddy”: Looking for good shape oranges and some golds. Contrasting big colourful lips will be a feature.

GB1913	Rui Xavier “Veldt” x Sundaani’s Treasure “Orange Crush”: Compact growth habit in percentage. Bright oranges on tall stems and contrasting lips.

<u>Albas / Pure Colour Expectancy</u>	
GB1914	Loch Watten “Dural” x Ocean “Tee Pee”: Beautiful mid-season white albas with yellow lip markings. Odd green possible given the background.

GB1915	Purely Dreaming “Gosh” x (Sleeping Nymph x Zuma Spring) “Dural”: “Gosh” has been giving some beautiful greens. Expect greens and golds with good form.

<u>Predominantly Red Expectancy</u>	
GB1916	Regal Flame “Queen of Hearts” x Kimberley Splash “TP”: “TP” is like a palette and will take the colour of the other parent and impart good shape. Expect mainly reds.

<p>“Hawaii” (on the left) is a spring flowering lavender that can carry up to 5 enormous blooms on a stem and is very long lasting. Shape is excellent without manipulation. Plus, it has a really strong perfume. For the past decade it has impressed me and I finally decided to use it. “CM#8” also flowers in spring and can carry up to 5 large blooms. Expect big, long lasting beautiful lavender to purple cattleyas in spring.</p>
